In particular, the judicial documentation of the Extraordinary Assizes Courts (CAS) has proved to be decisive for the historical reconstruction of the facts and their representation. The project, focused on the study of the conflict and its lacerations in the territorial context of Emilia Romagna, aims to collect and census over a three-year period all the judgments of the regional courts, from a few years accessible at the State Archives, entering the data relating to trials and defendants within the database of the National Institute Ferruccio Parri.

Modena 900 is a free application for smartphones and tablets made on the 70th anniversary of the Liberation, which allows you to access a map of 75 places in the city where you can see monuments, memorial stones, tombstones and shrines dedicated to the partisan struggle. Through this tool it is possible to know the history of these places and of the people, 451 partisans, military and civilians, who are commemorated there.

A portal to learn about the profound changes in the province.

The history of the province of Modena in the twentieth century is made of great and profound changes, which, from poor and backward territory, make it an advanced and dynamic area culturally, economically, socially and politically.

To allow this inversion are first the people who have lived and worked there. For this reason, the portal Modena 900 wants to make available to all, the hundreds of biographies of Modena who took part in the history of the province in an open space, implementable, scientifically guaranteed.

Through databases, apps and multimedia resources, it is intended to make clear the connections between these life stories, the territory and history and enhance experiences and initiatives already consolidated, but who have not yet had the chance to get out of the narrow circles of researchers and history enthusiasts.

## Fascism in Emilia-Romagna An original research project curated by 11 Historical Institutes of Emilia Romagna

On the occasion of the centenary of the march on Rome, the Historical Institutes of Emilia Romagna have launched a research project aimed at exploring the contexts of the individual provinces where the origins of fascism took root and developed. This great work, which brings out the local specificities but also explains the regional characteristics of fascism, aims to promote critical reflection on the reasons, times and forms of the squadrista affirmation in Emilia-Romagna, questioning the superficiality and the image of a fascism without responsibility that until a few years ago animated the political and cultural debate.

This is a great opportunity to analyze archival documents with new eyes and focus on the gravity of the political issues of the early decades of the twentieth century. All this gives us a picture of the historical facts extremely complex and far from the widespread Goliardic representation.
